- (1) Installation of Very High Frequency Station in the Court at Barpeta:-

The Monitoring Committee has discussed about the failure of installation of Very High Frequency Station in Court at Barpeta. The District & Sessions Judge Barpeta and the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barpeta have expressed their dissatisfaction regarding the non-compliance of the resolutions of the Monitoring Committee regarding the V.H.F. Station. The Addl. SP(H.Q), Barpeta has informed that though they have written to their higher authority for clarification regarding installation of the V.H.F. Station, but no response is received till today. He has requested to furnish a copy of the suggestions which were put forward in the Administrative Conference held at Goalpara on 24-09-2016. Accordingly, the meeting has decided to furnish a copy of the suggestions put forward by the aforesaid Administrative Conference to the Addl.SP(H.Q), Barpeta and asked him to take necessary steps for early installation of the Very High Frequency Station in Court at Barpeta.



(2) Regarding investigation of the cases:-


The meeting has discussed about the quality of the investigation of the cases. The District & Sessions Judge, Barpeta and the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barpeta have advised for some training to the Investigating officers regarding the proper investigation of the case. The Public Prosecutor, Barpeta has stated that no Crime Conference is held during last 2/3 years. If such conference is held regularly then the lack of investigations are to be discussed and then the police officials mainly the I/Os will know the draw backs of their investigating. So, the Monitoring Committee has asked the police administration to hold the Crime Conference regularly.

(3) Regarding status of criminal cases pending against sitting M.P. and M.L.A in the district:-


The Public Prosecutor, Barpeta has informed that at present there is no criminal case pending for trial against any M.P. or M.L.A.






